

What is an Enterprise Zone?

- It is a state-regulated economic development tool.
- It exempts businesses from local taxes for new investment.
- The tax exemption is a minimum of 3 years and can be up to 15 years.
- There are 73 in Oregon. Three-quarters are in rural communities.

Standard Exemption - Total exemption from local taxes

- Two years during construction
- 3 to 5 years once operational

Long-term Rural Exemption


- 7 to 15 years exemption in 39 rural enterprise zones
- Areas with issues around long-standing unemployment

Schools

- Voters capped property taxes. Oregon created equitable funding formula in the 1991.
- In the late 1990s, the Legislature created opportunity for levies to support operations.
- Now, communities find many ways to support schools outside the funding formula.


